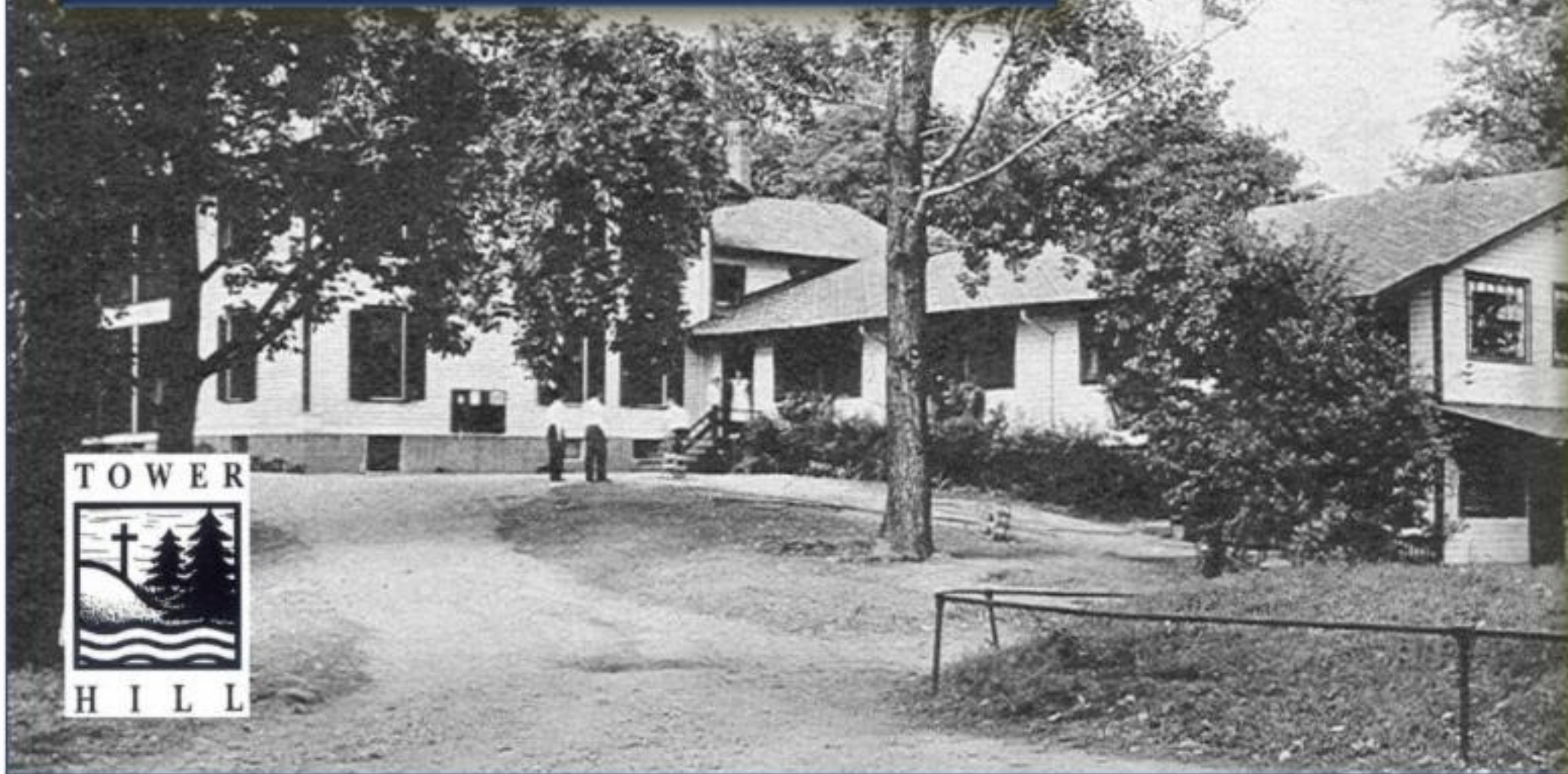


Tower Hill, changing lives for close to 100 years
